Objectives For Series

1. Help identify our fears and what is not of God.
2. Help us set aside our fears so that faith may take its rightful place, and we might experience life to its full.

KEY POINTS

1. When God says, “**Do not fear,**” He gives us a **promise** why not to fear.

- Vv 26:3-4
- Relational. Gen:6, Gal 2:26-29, Phil 3:9-10
- Enemy of faith is fear
- Fear is like kryptonite to Holy Spirit when you give in to it.
- **Certainly , I will be with you. Raja/Jadadesh**

2. “Holding onto God’s hand” (believe in the **certainty of His presence**) is the safest way to cross the “streets of life.”

Key Points

3. We must take on God's perspective on losses.
 - A. Embrace them as God's will. "Success" is filled with losses. Rom 8:28
 - B. Let go of them so we can pick up the "shovel" to dig a new well.
 - C. Dig one shovel at a time.

4. **Refuse** to allow the gravity of your loss or their frequency to change your view of God or His presence with you.
