- A. Matthew 28:18 all authority given Therefore go...
- B. Matthew 10:1, 7 "authority" defined:
 - 1. Over the demons, v 8
 - 2. Heal the sick, v 8
 - 3. As you go, preach the kingdom of God is at hand. V 7.

"AUTHORITY" GIVEN BY CHRIST ON FOUR SEPARATE OCCASIONS:

- Choosing of the 12 disciples Mark 3:14-15; Christ's purpose stated.
- 2. Sending out of the 12 disciples Matt 10:1, 7; Mark 6:7, 12-13; Luke 9:1
- 3. Sending out of the 70 Luke 10:1f, 9; 19-20
- 4. Commissioning of disciples Matt 28:18f

ALONG WITH THE AUTHORITY CAME THE PROMISE OF SPIRITUAL POWER

- Luke 24:49
- Acts 1:8
- •1 Cor 4:20
- Ep 1:18-19

THE CHURCH BEGAN AT PENTECOST

- Acts 2:2-4, 2:19 Joel 2 prophecy fulfilled.
- Acts 5:15. Peter's shadow was said to heal if it fell upon someone.
- Not just apostles:
 - · Stephen (not an apostle) Acts 6:8
 - Philip (not an apostle) Acts 8:13

WHAT SHOULD WE EXPECT WHEN WE CLAIM THE AUTHORITY?

- 1. Resistance and division.
 - Matt 10:16-17
 - Luke 12:51-53
 - Acts 14:3-4
- 2. The outpouring of the Spirit.
 - Luke 10:1, ahead of where Christ is coming. Matt 10:7

BUT WHY? WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORITY AND POWER?

- 1. Matthew 9:35 10:1
 - Sheep without a shepherd.
 - · No one to guide, protect, feed.
- 2. Our spiritual armor. Ep 6:12
 - Our struggle is not against flesh and blood but the powers of the enemy.

TO GO IN THE GREAT COMMISSION POWER

- 1. You and I are power-supplies for the Holy Spirit waiting to be engaged.
 - · Harvest is plentiful. Workers are few.
 - Don't let your shortage keep you from going.
