 - 1. Latter part of last-things, His return and judgment
 - 2. God is the "man"
 - 3. We are the servants
 - 4. Talent was a sum of money; represents more than just money everything.

- Matthews 25:19, "settled accounts"
 - 1. Christians are accountable as stewards of God's awesome resources given to us;
 - 2. Time, finances, family, spiritual opportunities, careers, and spiritual gifts.
 - 1 Cor 4:2; Luke 16:10-13; Rom 14:12
 - Matt 6:1-4; 1 Cor 3:8-9, 11-15; Rev 14:13

IF WE ARE STEWARDS OF GODS PROPERTY....

- Does this impact how I spend, invest, or use what God has entrusted to me?
 - 1. What do you want me to do with your money and your possessions?
 - 2. Does it impact how much debt I incur?
 - 3. Does it impact whether I save?
 - 4. Does it impact whether I tithe?

- Hard work, expanding a business or investing:

 - •5 talent, 2 talent or 1 talent servants.
