# LAUNCH #3 GET READY FOR YOUR FAITH TO TAKE OFF! CONNECTED WE LOVE

John 15:9-13, 17

### DISCIPLES ARE COMMANDED TO LOVE ONE ANOTHER.

- A. John 13:34-35
  - John 15:12, John 15:17
- I am human. Not natural.
- "And because lawlessness is increased, most people's love will grow cold. (Matt. 24:12 NAS)

### LOVE OF GOD IS THE FIRST FRUIT/PROOF OF BEING A DISCIPLE.

### A. God is love.

- And we have come to know and have believed the love which God has for us. God is love, and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him. (1 Jn. 4:16 NAS)
- B. God's love in us bears witness by our loving others.

### THE ABSENCE OF LOVE IN A DISCIPLE SHOULD BE A WARNING.

 Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.<sup>8</sup>
 The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love. (1 Jn. 4:7-8)

### THE ABSENCE OF LOVE IN A DISCIPLE SHOULD BE A WARNING.

 If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for the one who does not love his brother whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen. 21 And this commandment we have from Him, that the one who loves God should love his brother also. -- 1 Jn. 4:20-21 (NASB)

### WHAT IS THE FOUNDATION OF LOVING OTHERS??

- A. The love of Christ (savior) has not been made personal to me. John 3:16.
  - "We love, because He first loved us." (1 Jn. 4:19 NAS)

- 4. WHY DO I NOT "FEEL" LIKE LOVING OTHERS?:
- Not born again (so God is not in me). 1 Jn 4:8, 20-21; 5:10
- 2. Stopped abiding; dried up. Jn 15:6
- Obedience is a convenience; not surrendered. Jn 15:10, 1 Jn 5:7; Matt 11:28-30

### 5. LOVE IS A "VERB." CHRIST GAVE IT MEANING FOR US.

### A. Not a feeling.

- 1 John 3:16, 18, "We know love by this, that He laid down His life for us; and we out to lay down our lives for our brethren. ... Little children, let us not love with word or with tongue but in deed and truth."
- John 15:13
- Acts 2:42-45

- A. Not superficial. Jn 15:14
- B. Rom 12:9-21

### WHAT DOES LOVE LOOK LIKE?

 Rom. 12:9-21 Let love be without hypocrisy. .... 10 Be devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor; 11 not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; 12 rejoicing in hope, persevering in tribulation, devoted to prayer, 13 contributing to the needs of the saints, practicing hospitality. 14 Bless those who persecute you; bless and curse not. ...

# 5. WHAT DOES LOVE LOOK LIKE? (CONT)

 15 Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep. 16 Be of the same mind toward one another; do not be haughty in mind, but associate with the lowly. Do not be wise in your own estimation. 17 Never pay back evil for evil to anyone. .... 18 If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men. 19 ...." 21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good. --Rom. 12:9-21 (NASB)
