JOHN 16:7 - 15

1. SOME OF THE WAYS THE FATHER HAS SPOKEN TO US

1. **Directly in Scripture** – “God said,” “Lord said,” “Says the Lord,” “The word of the Lord...” – 1024x.
2. **Through Creation.** Ps 33:6, Heb 11:3, Romans 1:20
3. He spoke about **Himself** and His **ways**. Gen 1:26, 2:18; Isa 57:15
4. **People. He talked to us.** Adam, Cain, Moses, Noah, Abraham; prophets – 415x

1. SOME OF THE WAYS THE FATHER HAS SPOKEN TO US

5. Conversations had **purpose** and **meaning**. Isa 55:11, Jer 29:11, Rev 3:22
6. In the last days, **he has spoken to us in Jesus**. Heb 1:1-2

IN THE LAST DAYS – HE HAS SPOKEN TO US IN JESUS.

- **Hebrews 1:1** God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, ² in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world. (Heb. 1:1-2 NAU)

2. THE SUM OF HIS “TALKS,” HIS “WORDS,” TOOK ON HUMAN FORM IN JESUS.

- **John 1:1** In the beginning **was the Word**, and the **Word was with God**, and the **Word was God**.² He was in the beginning with God.
- **John 1:14** And the **Word became flesh**, and dwelt among us, ...
- **John 1:17** ...The only begotten God, ..., **he has explained him**.

3. THE ROLE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IS TO CONTINUE THE CONVERSATION.

A. John 16:14-15

B. When we hear him “talk about Jesus,” we will glorify Jesus.

C. One on one conversation because He indwells believers. 1 Cor
