- V 38 – Let it be done to me ...
 - **Baby** out of wedlock
 - Joseph **not the father**
 - Called Son of God **bc of conception**
 - **Throne of David – how to raise the SOG?**
 - A **witness.**

2. NO ONE CAN STAY IN GOD'S WILL WITHOUT *MEETING* WITH HIM.

- Amos 3:3, “Do two walk together unless they have agreed to meet”?
 - Hebrews 11:6
 - Matt 11:28-30
 - Luke 1:39-40

4. TO FIND FREEDOM WE MUST EXCHANGE THE APPROVAL OF OTHERS FOR THE APPROVAL OF GOD.

- Luke 9:23
- Mary's exchanges:
 - Approval of family
 - Approval of friends
 - Approval of religious authorities

3. Take an inventory of your daily complaints. Ask God to reveal to you whether the level of your complaining is an indication of “I will” or “thy will” in your life.
